In 2012 Light of Christ Anglican Church (LoC) was planted in the Sun City retirement community. In 2015, LoC took bold steps to become an established intergenerational Anglican church in Georgetown by moving out of Sun City and calling a full-time rector with a young family. God blessed this step of faith with consistent spiritual and numerical growth over the last seven years. Now new visitors to LoC find a healthy and hospitable congregation with every age represented and worshipping together.

This desire for a hospitable multi-generational Anglican church fuels the practical need for a more permanent building. To fund this vision we desire to raise \$1.37 million to help finance either acquiring an existing building or to purchase land and build.

This investment will further our vision to be a beacon of Christ in Central Texas for generations to come. *It will provide a sacred space where the ancient faith of the “one holy catholic and apostolic church” is made manifest through the Anglican way, and a launching point for mission and church planting.*
